- ❖ The cabinet below contains Audio-Visual components including a DVD player
- ❖ The inside of the cabinet door holds the Emergency preparedness DVD and instruction sheet



Pioneer DVD Player

Located inside the Cabinet

- The DVD player is the only component you will need to access inside the cabinet
- The cabinet does not supply a VCR player
- The volume and all other control needs are accessed through the touch screen

AMX Touch Screen

1. Touch screen anywhere to begin
2. The screen should be powered on at all times but it does have a ON/OFF button
3. This screen will take you to the Home Screen to access Audio-Visual components



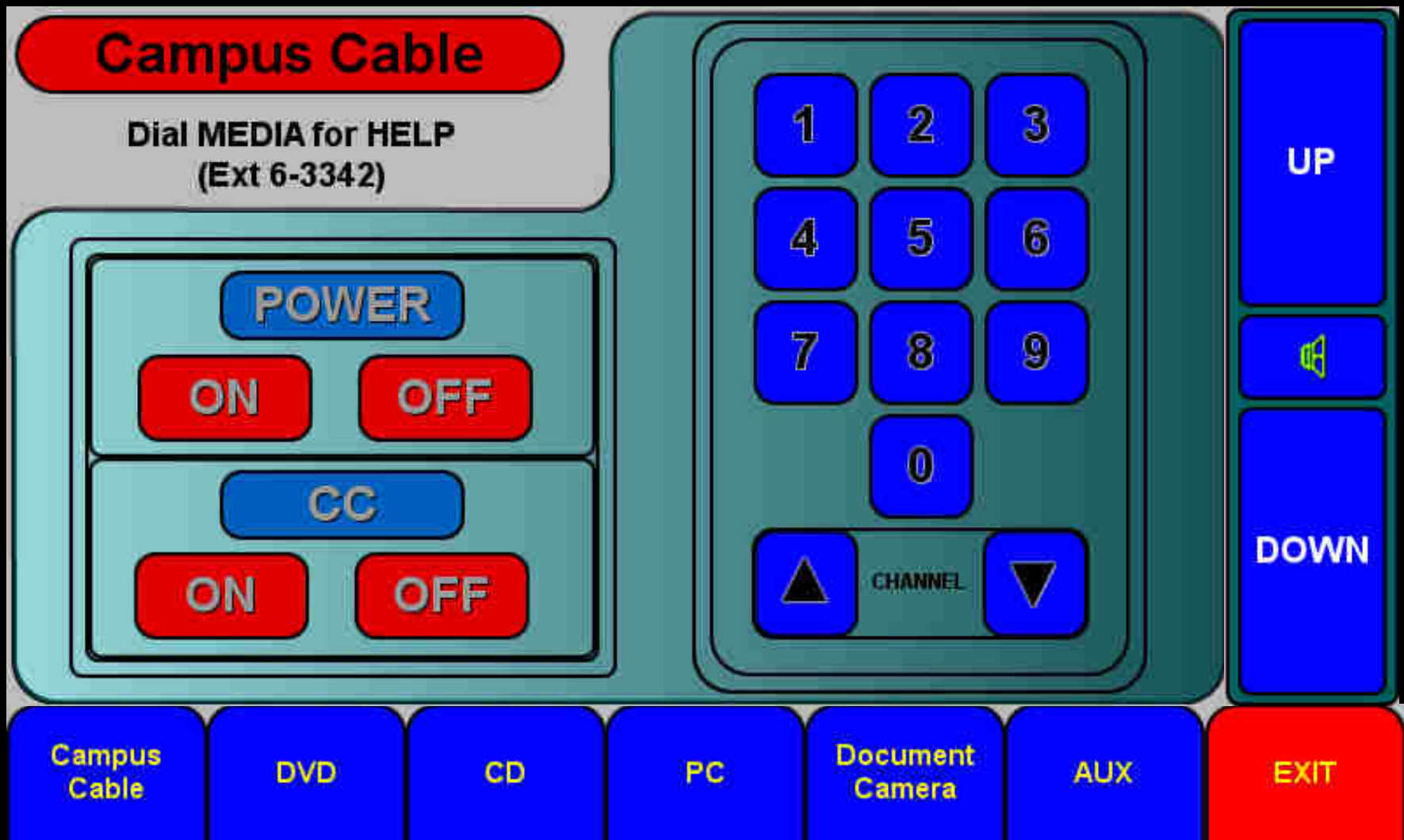
The HOME screen

Campus Cable Touch Screen

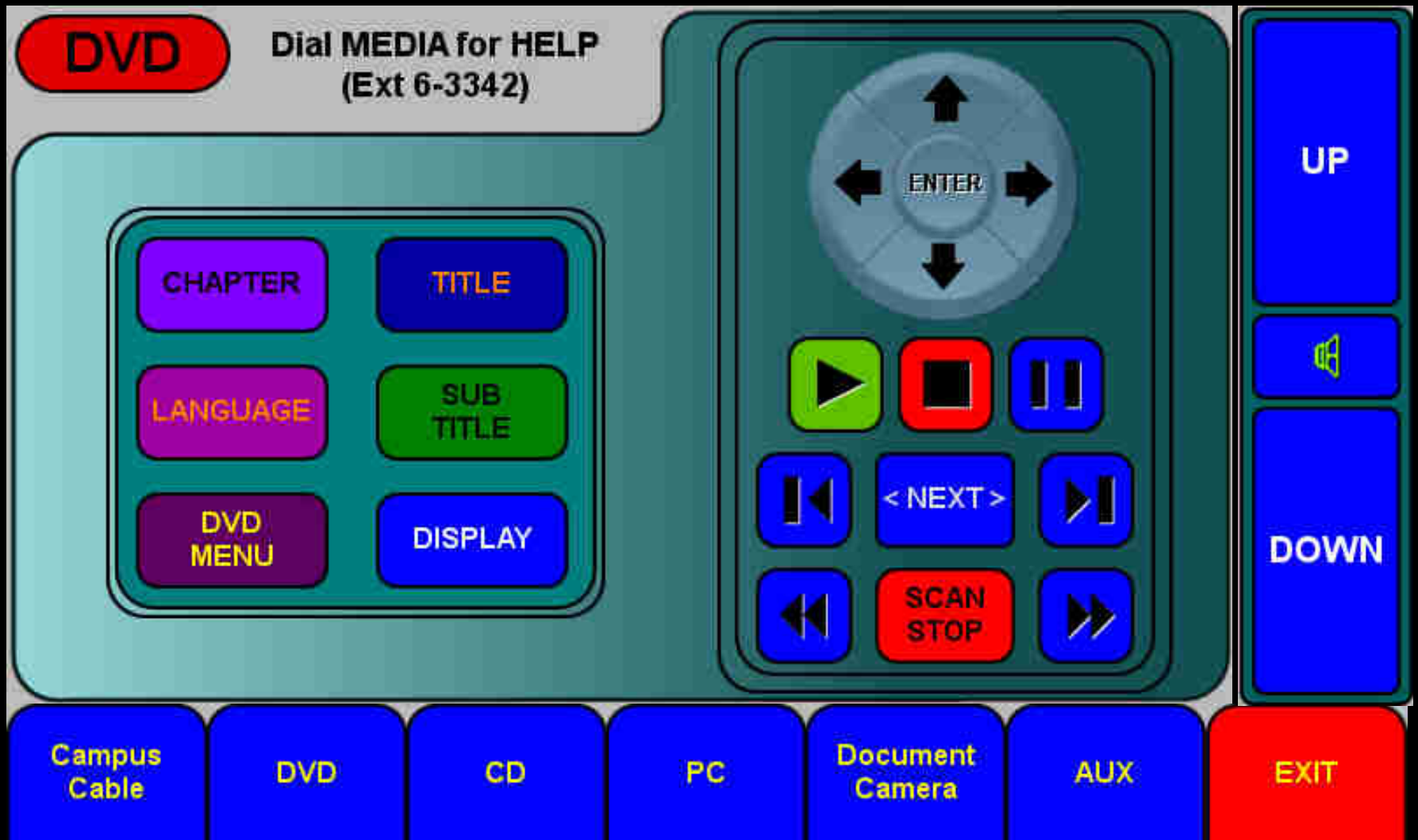


Campus Cable

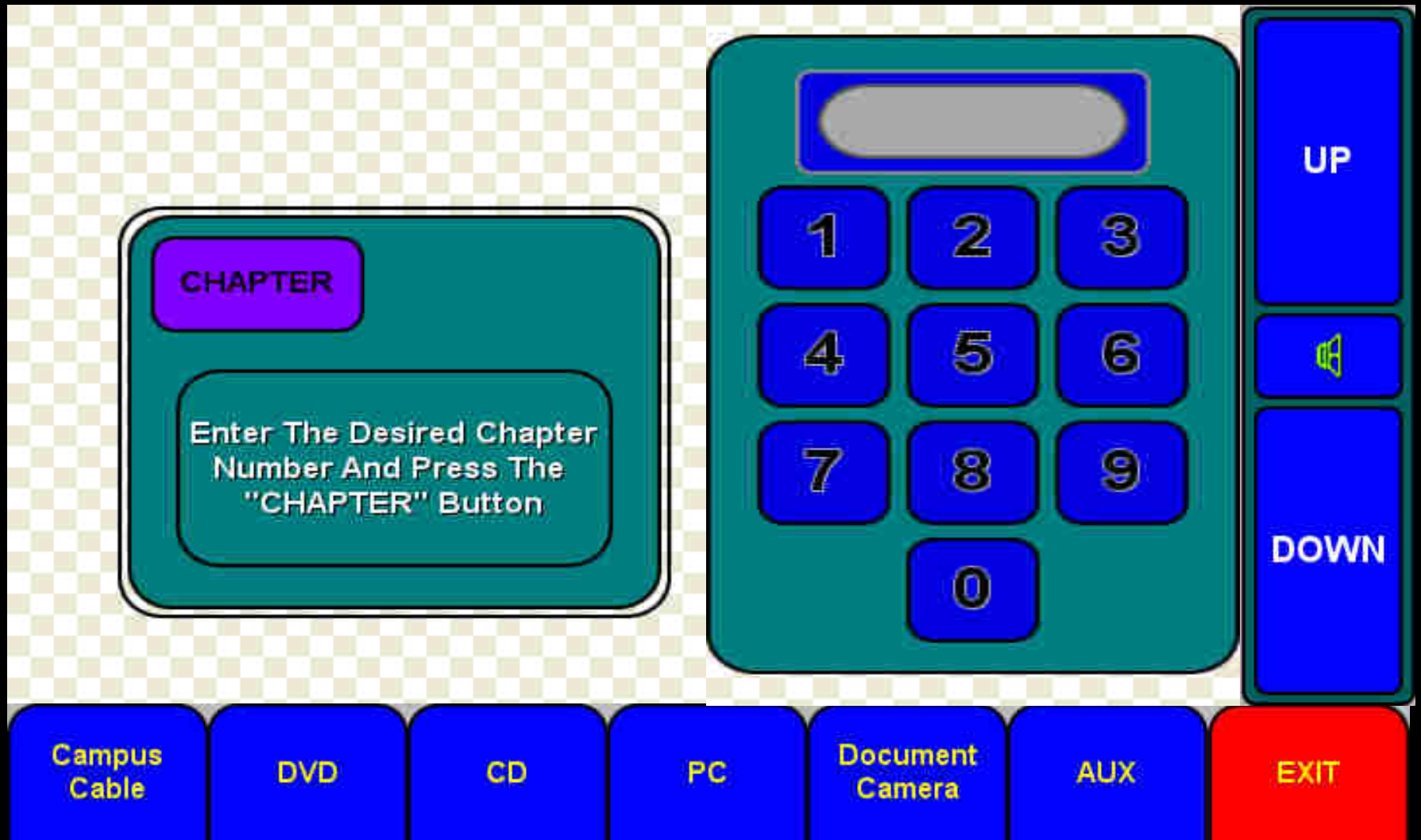
- Classroom Support Help Desk #

- UP & Down – Increase or decrease volume & mute speaker
- May switch sources from tabs at bottom or Exit system

Pioneer DVD Player

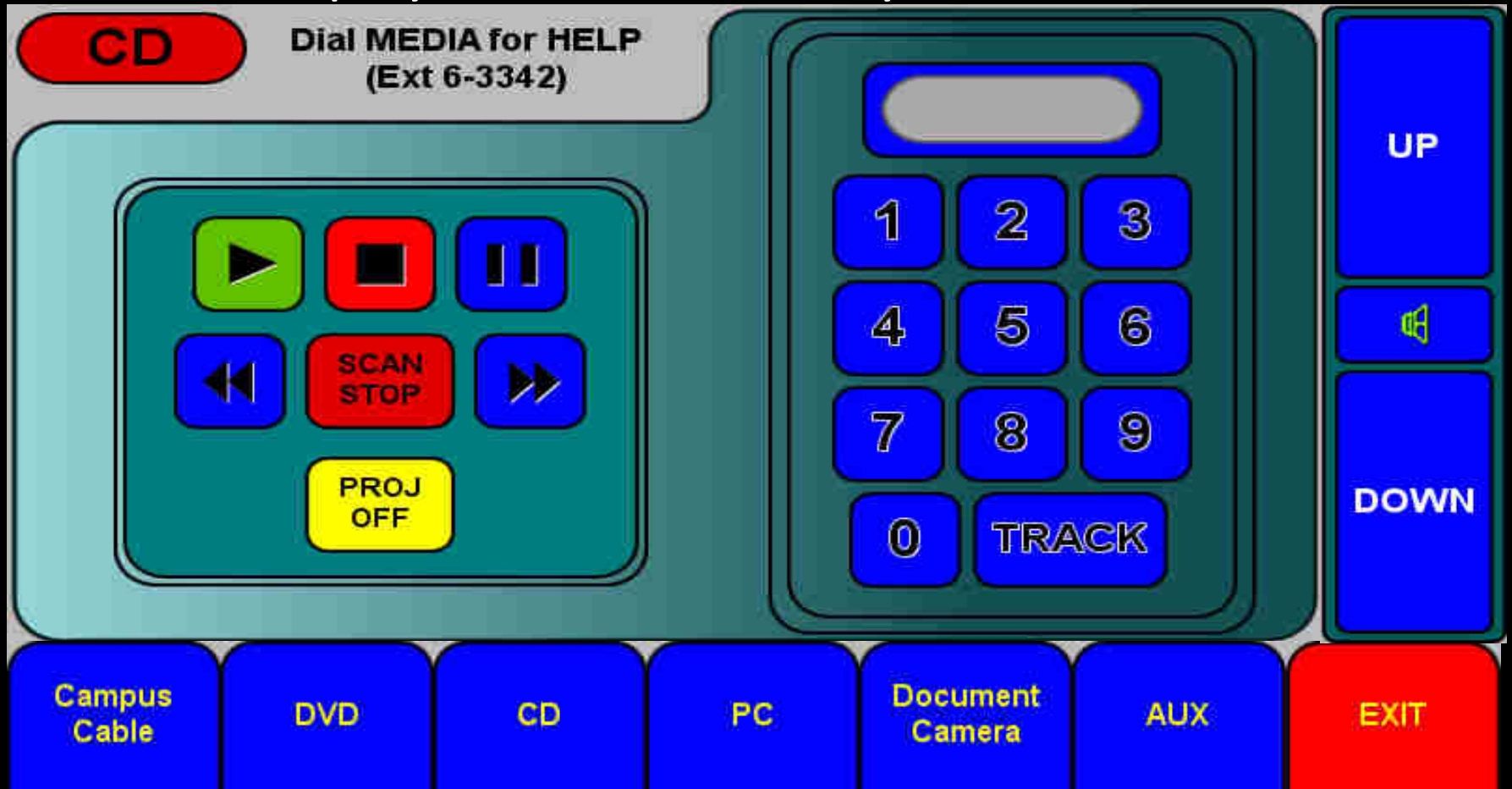
➤ If the progressive scan button to the left of the drawer is **GREEN** you will have audio but NO video

➤ Hold down button until the **GREEN** light turns off and the video signal will return.

- ❖ **Red**- Right Speaker

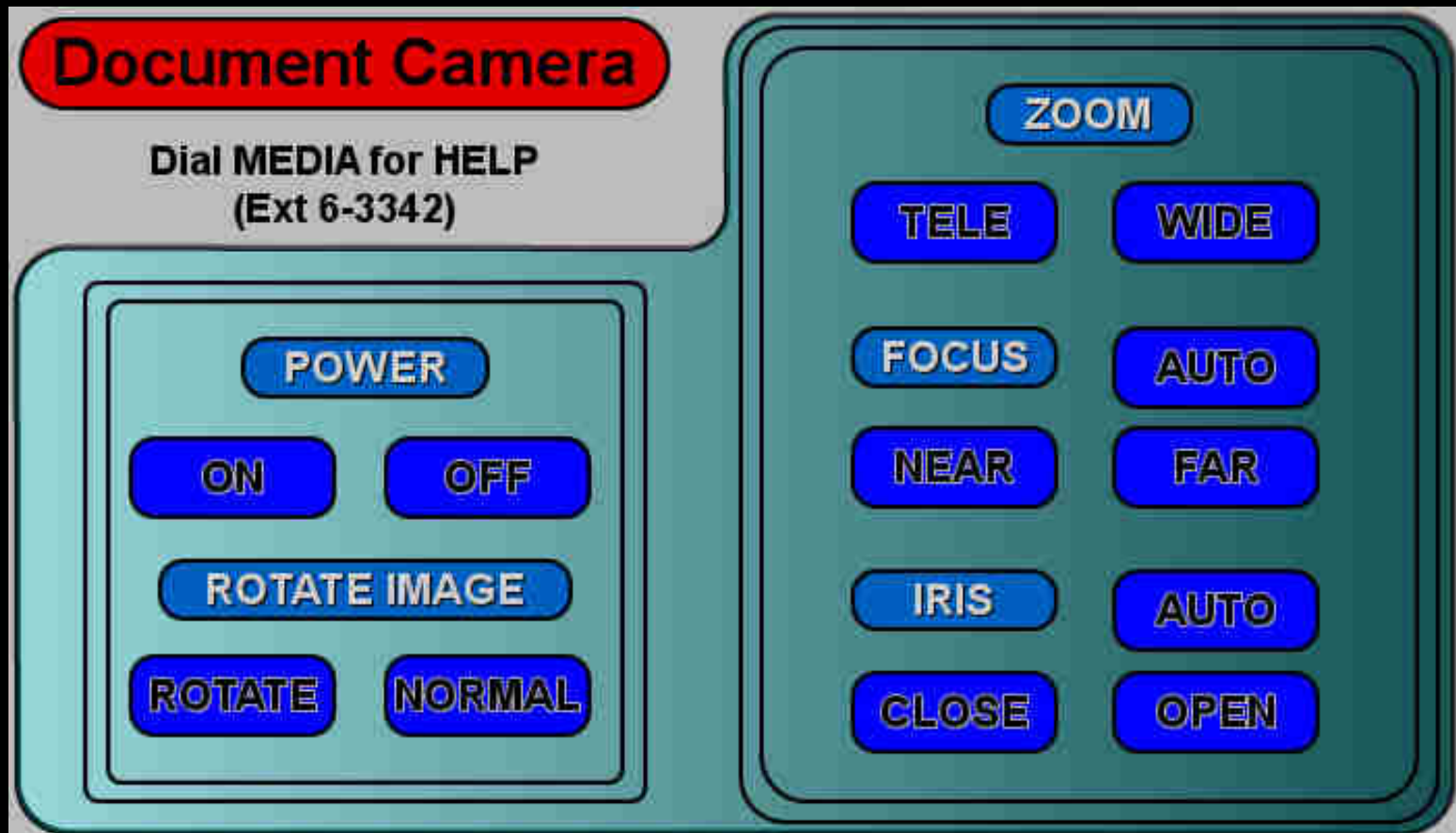
PC Port
